The National Religious Campaign Against Torture (NRCAT), a coalition of over 125 religious organizations committed to ending U.S.-sponsored torture, has been chosen by the Ploughshares Fund to be one of twelve organizations participating in its Peace Primary which takes place during the months of September and October.
